Village of Roseville Receives Grant

The Village of Roseville received a \$700,954 Clean Ohio Assistance Fund grant for costs associated with remediation activities on the former Brush Pottery property. The project property is located at 87 Perry Street. The grant will be used for asbestos abatement, waste removal, and soil remediation. After rehabilitation of the property, Jeff Nelson Custom Homes plans to acquire the property and invest \$15,000 to redevelop the site with 4,200 square feet of commercial space for the offices and storage space of Jeff Nelson Custom Homes. Future plans include an additional investment of \$60,000 by Jeff Nelson Custom Homes to build condominiums and small homes, which could result in job creation.
